**BILL NO 3**

**THE WAIKATO DIOCESAN CATHEDRALS AMENDMENT BILL 2012**

The Synod of the Diocese of Waikato and Taranaki enacts as follows –

**1. TITLE**

This Statute is the Waikato Diocesan Cathedrals Amendment Statute 2012.

**2. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Statute is to add to, clarify and amend the provisions in the Waikato Diocesan Cathedrals Statute 2006 relating to the appointment of Canons of the Cathedrals and to make provision for Deeds of Collation for the appointment of Canons of the Cathedrals.

**3. COMMENCEMENT**

This Statute shall come into force at the close of the Synod at which it is enacted.

**4. AMENDMENT OF CLAUSE 10**

Clause 10 of the Statute is amended as follows:

- (1) By the deletion of sub-clause (1) and its replacement by a new sub-clause (1) as follows:

- (1) The Cathedral may have up to four Clerical Canons and four Lay Canons. Half their number, two Clerical Canons and two Lay Canons, shall be appointed by the Bishops and half their number, two Clerical Canons and two Lay Canons, shall be nominated by the Dean for appointment by the Bishops. Such Canons shall be chosen from amongst the clergy and laity resident in the Bishopric, and shall be nominated for their leadership in a defined area of ministry or Christian service. Nominations need not be restricted to members of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa, New Zealand and Polynesia.
- (2) By the deletion of sub-clause (2) and its replacement by a new sub-clause (2) as follows:
  - (2) The Bishops may appoint as Canon Theologian a person who is otherwise suitable and who holds academic qualifications in theology, preferably at doctoral level from a recognised University, and may appoint as Canon Registrar the Diocesan Registrar Manager. Such appointments are in addition to the appointments provided for in sub-clause (1) of this clause.
- (3) By the addition of a new sub-clause (3) as follows:
  - (3) On the nomination of the Dean the Bishops may appoint Canons in Residence from amongst the clergy on the staff of the Cathedral. Canons in Residence are not members of the Cathedral Chapter.
- (4) By the consequential renumbering of the remaining sub-clauses of clause 10 as sub-clauses (4) to (8).

## **5. AMENDMENT OF CLAUSE 17**

Clause 17 of the Statute is amended as follows:

- (1) By the deletion of sub-clause (1) and its replacement by a new sub-clause (1) as follows:
  - (1) The Cathedral may have up to four Clerical Canons and four Lay Canons. Half their number, two Clerical Canons and two Lay Canons, shall be appointed by the Bishops and half their number, two Clerical Canons and two Lay Canons, shall be nominated by the Dean for appointment by the Bishops. Such Canons shall be chosen from amongst the clergy and laity resident in the Bishopric and shall be nominated for their leadership in a defined area of ministry or Christian service. Nominations need not be restricted to members of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa, New Zealand and Polynesia.
- (2) By the deletion of sub-clause (2) and its replacement by a new sub-clause (2) as follows:
  - (2) The Bishops may appoint as Canon Theologian a person who is otherwise suitable and who holds academic qualifications in theology, preferably at doctoral level from a recognised University, and may appoint as Canon Registrar the Diocesan Registrar Manager. Such appointments are in addition to the appointments provided for in sub-clause (1) of this clause.

- (3) By the addition of a new sub-clause (3) as follows:
  - (3) On the nomination of the Dean the Bishops may appoint Canons in Residence from amongst the clergy on the staff of the Cathedral. Canons in Residence are not members of the Cathedral Chapter.
- (4) By the consequential renumbering of the remaining sub-clauses of clause 17 as sub-clauses (4) to (8)

**6. DEEDS OF COLLATION**

A new clause 18 is added to the Statute as follows:

- (18) The appointment of Canons pursuant to clause 10 (1), (2), (3), (7) and (8) and clause 17 (1), (2), (3), (7) and (8) of this Statute shall be evidenced by completed relevant Deeds of Collation in the forms set out in the Schedule to this Statute or to the like effect.

### **BILL NO 4**

#### **THE MISCELLANEOUS STATUTES AMENDMENT BILL 2012**

The Synod of the Diocese of Waikato and Taranaki enacts as follows –

**TITLE**

This Statute is the Miscellaneous Statutes Amendment Statute 2012.

**2. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Statute is to make minor amendments to various Statutes to clarify or amend provisions, or to correct errors.

**3. COMMENCEMENT**

This Statute comes into force at the close of the Synod at which it is enacted.

**4. THE BOUNDARIES OF THE LOCAL MINISTRY AND MISSION UNITS IN THE DIocese OF WAIKATO STATUTE 1996**

Part Three of the First Schedule is amended by the deletion of the heading: "The Mission District of St James, Nixon Street" and its replacement with the heading: "The Mission District of St James, Hamilton East".

**5. THE WAIKATO DIOCESAN STATUTE OF STANDING COMMITTEE 1994**

- (1) Clause 5 (3) (c) is amended by the deletion of all the words following the words: "from their own Order".
- (2) Clauses 5 (3) (d) and 5 (3) (e) are deleted.

(3) Clause 9 (3) (b) is amended by the deletion of the words: “Councils, Task Groups, Boards or Committees” and their replacement with the words: “Boards or Sub-committees”.

(4) Clause 9 (3) (e) is amended by the deletion of the word: “Council” and its replacement with the word: “Sub-committee”.

#### **6. THE STANDING ORDERS STATUTE 1972**

(1) Clause 41 is amended by the deletion of sub-clauses (1) and (2) and their replacement with the following sub-clause:

(1) All Divisions shall be taken in Houses and the President shall appoint one clerical teller for the House of Clergy and one lay teller for the House of Laity. Members of the Synod wishing to abstain from voting shall remain seated in the Synod hall and those wishing to vote shall retire, in Houses, from the Synod hall. The teller for each house, using the list of members present prepared by the Registrar at the beginning of each day, shall record their own votes first and then record the votes of those wishing to vote “Aye” and the votes of those wishing to vote “No” by marking the list appropriately. The secretaries to the Synod shall record the Bishops’ votes. The tellers shall deliver the lists to the President who shall declare the result of the voting in each House.

(2) Clause 46 is replaced with the following:

At its first meeting following Synod each year, the Standing Committee shall appoint a sub-committee to review the statutes of the Diocese. This Sub-committee shall consist of the Diocesan Manager/Registrar and up to four members, at least three of whom shall be a Barrister or Solicitor of the High Court of New Zealand of not less than three years’ standing and must be a member of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa, New Zealand and Polynesia.

#### **7. THE WAIKATO DIOCESAN STATUTE OF SYNOD 1994**

Clause 15 is amended by the addition of a new sub-clause as follows:

(5) Every member of Synod in the House of Clergy and every member of Synod in the House of Laity is required to sign the roll of his or her House each day prior to the commencement of the morning session. Members who have not so signed shall not be eligible to vote when a Division is called during that day.

#### **8. THE PARISHES STATUTE 2009**

Clause 10 is amended by the addition of the words “from among the laity” as follows:

(1) In sub-clause (2), after the words “appointed annually”

(2) In sub-clause (3), after the words “elected annually”

(3) In sub-clause (4), after the word “elected”

(4) In sub-clause (6), after the word “elected”.

#### **9. THE FINANCE STATUTE 1991**

(1) The first paragraph of clause 4 is amended by the deletion of the words: “Council established by The Diocesan Councils and Task Groups Statute

2003 and the functions, duties and responsibilities of the Finance and Administration Council shall be those set out in that Statute” and their replacement by the word: “Sub-committee”.

- (2) Clause 4 is further amended by the addition of a new sub-clause as follows:
  - (4) All parishes not using the Parish Accounting service shall make all payments due to the Diocese by direct debit.
- (3) Clause 5 (1) (f) is amended by the deletion of all the words following the words: “The budgets of Diocesan” and their replacement by the word: “Sub-committees”.
- (4) Clause 5 (1) (h) is further amended by the deletion of the word: “Council” and its replacement by the word: “Sub-committee”.
- (5) Clause 5 (5) is amended by the addition of new sub-clauses as follows:
  - j) Where a parish:
    - (i) has no vicarage, or
    - (ii) its vicarage has been sold, or is otherwise not available as a residence for the Vicar, and
    - (iii) the parish is paying a housing allowance to the Vicar,  
  
80% of that housing allowance.
  - k) Grants from external funders for specified programmes.

**10. THE LAY MINISTRY LICENCES STATUTE 2011**

Clause 7 is amended by the deletion of sub-clause (9).

**11. THE CLERGY STIPEND STATUTE 1973**

Clause 8 is deleted and replaced by the following clause:

- (1) Each ministry unit or regional council shall pay monthly to the Diocese on or before the 14<sup>th</sup> day of each month the full amounts to which the Vicar and other Clergy for whom it *is responsible are entitled pursuant to this Statute (inclusive of Accident Compensation and other levies)*.
- (2) On or before the 16<sup>th</sup> day of each month the Diocesan Manager shall pay all stipends to which Vicars and other Clergy are entitled, less any contribution due to the New Zealand Anglican Church Pension Fund and any other approved deductions.

**12. THE WAIKATO DIOCESAN STATUTE OF PASTORS 1993**

Clause 10 is amended by the deletion of sub-clause (2) (n).

**"That the 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading be an Order for later in the day."**

**That this Synod notes that there is no limit on the time a parishioner may remain in office and resolves that:**

- (a) where an office is filled by appointment or election, the incumbent may serve no more than three consecutive terms up to a maximum of six years in that office, and will not be eligible for re-appointment to that office for a period of 12 months;**
- (b) a parishioner who is ineligible for reappointment because of clause (a) may be used in an advisory capacity if required;**
- (c) a period of two years grace be given before this motion takes effect to allow parishes to plan for succession.**

The President ruled that the motion tabled was substantially different from the motion left lying on the table at Synod 2011, and ruled the motion as contentious.

It was agreed that the mover of this motion should liaise with the Statutes Revision Sub Committee in good time before Synod 2013 so that an appropriate motion could be prepared for consideration by the Synod..
